

Registration Form for Powered Personal Transportation Devices Used on Rough and Tumble Grounds

All powered personal transportation devices used on the grounds must be registered with Rough and Tumble. This includes but is not limited to: Golf Carts, ATV's, Lawn Mowers, Doodlebugs, Handmade rigs of any kind.

This does not include single seat riders commercially designed for and operated by handicapped individuals.

All personal transportation devices must be registered by an adult (over 18 years of age). The adult will be held responsible for the safe operation of the device and for its adherence to Rough and Tumble's rules. The registering adult shall also be held solely responsible for any personal injury or property damage caused by the operation of the device. A registration tag will be issued for each device. The tag must be attached to the device and be visible at all times.

Rules of Operation:

- **MAXIMUM ALLOWED SPEED AT ALL TIMES IS 5 MILES PER HOUR**
- **Pedestrians SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES**
- A headlamp is required for operation after dusk
 - The headlamp shall have the illumination of at least the equivalent of a working 2-D Cell flashlight
- All drivers must abide by the signs limiting access from the Main Gate to just beyond the Rough and Tumble kitchen. This area is off limits at all times. With the exception of specially authorized vehicles.
- ANY GARDEN TRACTOR DRIVER UNDER THE AGE OF 15 MUST TAKE OUR GARDEN TRACTOR SAFETY COURSE. UPON COMPLETION OF THE COURSE, THEY WILL RECEIVE A BADGE WHICH MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE DRIVING THE GARDEN TRACTOR. Any youth seen driving a garden tractor without the safety course badge will be stopped, the garden tractor parked and the youth returned to their parents by a staff member of Rough and Tumble.

Violations of any of these rules may, at Rough and Tumble's sole discretion, result in the following measures: Verbal warning, Suspension of riding privileges, Revocation of riding privileges, Removal of the offending device from the grounds entirely.

These rules are adopted by Rough and Tumble Engineers Historical Assn. Board of Directors to ensure the safety of all persons attending the show and to keep rising insurance costs affordable.
